

The Village Water Department has announced that appointments are now being scheduled for the Water Meter Replacement Project. They will begin on Tuesday, November 29. Those residents who have received notices to schedule appointments should do so at their earliest convenience.

There had been some confusion earlier in the month when the contractor, East National Water, LLC, had failed to comply with requirements of the Putnam County Plumbing and Mechanical Trades Board which delayed the start of the project. “The issue was cleared up late last week and we look forward to getting the project underway,” said Supt. of Water & Sewer Greg Phillips. He added, “Residents should be sure that the area around their water meter is cleared before workers arrive to replace the meter.”

Several calls have come in to the office questioning what the meter looks like and where it would be located. The picture below is an example of a water meter installed on a service line. Generally speaking, water meters are located in a basement or crawlspace near the foundation wall closest to the street, though there are some exceptions.
