

Minutes of the Cold Spring Recreation Commission held on Wednesday, April 25, 2012 at 7 p.m.

The meeting began with an update by Donald McDonald on the progress with plans for the Putnam County bicentennial celebration in Cold Spring. Much of this has already been covered and documented in the minutes of Rec Commission meeting held on January 25, 2012.

Meaningful changes to the plan:

(1) The celebration has been changed from Saturday, June 9th to Sunday, June 10th with no rain date;

(2) The Wells Fargo stage coach will be positioned at the foot of Main Street although the horses will not be a part of the festivities due to concerns with the noise of motorcycles spooking the animals;

(3) Boy Scouts to raise the flag and several local politicians will briefly speak. Bruce will be provided with an agenda, detailing the day's activities. Recognizing the importance of this celebration, a full page ad in the Putnam County Legislative Gazette (with a cost of \$3,000) was discussed and will be brought up at the next Village meeting.

Next topic discussed was an update by Bruce on plans for the 4th of July celebration to be held on Wednesday with a rain date on Labor Day weekend. The festivities will include a parade, music and fireworks and there will be food available.

The issue of the maintenance of the various grounds was discussed. We want to make sure that the services of Flagler Landscaping, our current contractor, are overseen for quality and effectiveness.

For the upcoming year, the bidding for this service will be opened up to a larger number of providers.

Pop Warner's proposal for the installation of a telephone pole at Mayor's Park with enhanced lighting was discussed as this subject had been a topic for review at a recent village meeting and will be subject for further review in the near-term.

August 6--10, 8:45--3:15 p.m, Ball Field Park and Pavillion, Philipstown Rec Department baseball clinic, about 40 people --approved

Sunday, June 10th, 12 to 7 p.m., Mayor's Park Pavillion, Tom campanaile requesting Philipstown Cub Scouts --approved

Sundays July through August from 5 to 8 p.m., Cold Spring concert series at the Bandstand, 400 to 500 participants --approved
