

ZBA work session 01.10.13

The meeting called to order at 8:05 PM in the small conference room of Village Hall.

Attending: Dick Turner, Donald Mac Donald, Greg Gunder, Ed Murphy, John Martin and prospective board member Bernard Malloy.

No members of the public attended. The PCNR reporter was there.

Chairman Mac Donald introduced prospective board member Barney Molloy, and explained that with Barney's appointment to the board by the village board (currently slated for January 15th) current board member Ed Murphy would become an alternate board member ready to fill in for any absent member.
